- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 29.920 to read as follows:
- Sec. 29.920. SUICIDE PREVENTION. (a) The agency, in coordination with the Department of State Health Services, shall develop a comprehensive suicide prevention program for implementation in public high schools.
- 11 (b) The program must include components that provide for 12 training high school counselors, teachers, nurses, administrators, 13 and other staff, as well as law enforcement officers and social
- 15 (1) recognize students at risk of committing suicide;

workers who regularly interact with high school students, to:

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- 17 (2) intervene effectively with those students by
 18 providing all appropriate assistance, including referrals for
 19 mental health services.
- 20 <u>(c) In developing the program, the agency and the Department</u>
 21 <u>of State Health Services may consider any existing suicide</u>
 22 <u>prevention method developed by a school district under Section</u>
- 23 11.252(a)(3)(B) or 33.006(b)(1)(A).
- 24 (d) The agency may solicit and accept a gift, grant, or

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- 1 donation from any source for the development and implementation of
- 2 the program required by this section.
- 3 (e) Not later than January 1, 2011, the agency shall submit
- 4 a report to the legislature relating to the development and
- 5 implementation of the program required by this section. This
- 6 subsection expires September 1, 2011.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
