## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 29.153(a), (b), and (f), Education
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A district shall offer prekindergarten classes if the
- 8 district identifies 15 or more children who are [eligible under
- 9 Subsection (b) and are at least four years of age. A school
- 10 district may offer prekindergarten classes if the district
- identifies 15 or more eligible children who are at least three years
- 12 of age. A district may not charge tuition for a prekindergarten
- 13 class offered under this section.
- 14 (b) A child is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten
- 15 class under this section if the child is:
- 16 (1) at least three years of age and:
- 17  $\underline{\text{(A)}}$  [\(\frac{(1)}{1}\)] is unable to speak and comprehend the
- 18 English language;
- 19 <u>(B)</u>  $[\frac{(2)}{(2)}]$  is educationally disadvantaged;
- 20 (C) (3) is a homeless child, as defined by 42
- 21 U.S.C. Section 11434a, regardless of the residence of the child, of
- 22 either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other
- 23 person having lawful control of the child;
- (D)  $[\frac{(4)}{1}]$  is the child of an active duty member

- 1 of the armed forces of the United States, including the state
- 2 military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is
- 3 ordered to active duty by proper authority;
- 4 (E)  $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$  is the child of a member of the armed
- 5 forces of the United States, including the state military forces or
- 6 a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed
- 7 while serving on active duty; or
- 8 (F)  $[\frac{(6)}{}]$  is or ever has been in the
- 9 conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services
- 10 following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201,
- 11 Family Code; or
- 12 <u>(2) at least four years of age</u>.
- (f) A child who is eligible for enrollment in a
- 14 prekindergarten class under Subsection (b)(1)(D) or (E) [(b)(4) or
- 15 (5) remains eligible for enrollment if the child's parent leaves
- 16 the armed forces, or is no longer on active duty, after the child
- 17 begins a prekindergarten class.
- SECTION 2. Section 29.1532(c), Education Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (c) A school district that offers prekindergarten classes
- 21 shall include the following information in the district's Public
- 22 Education Information Management System (PEIMS) report:
- 23 (1) demographic information, as determined by the
- 24 commissioner, on students enrolled in district prekindergarten
- 25 classes, including the number of students who are eligible for
- 26 classes under Section 29.153(b)(1) [<del>29.153</del>];
- 27 (2) the numbers of half-day and full-day

- 1 prekindergarten classes offered by the district; and
- 2 (3) the sources of funding for the prekindergarten
- 3 classes.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 29.153(d), Education Code, is repealed.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 6 school year.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
