4	SECTION 1. Section 224.153, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
6	(e) A motor vehicle displaying the "hybrid vehicle"
7	insignia authorized by Section 502.1865 in an easily readable
8	location on the back of the vehicle may use a high occupancy vehicle
9	lane regardless of the number of occupants in the vehicle unless the
10	use would impair the receipt of federal funds.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
12	is amended by adding Section 502.1865 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 502.1865. "HYBRID VEHICLE" INSIGNIA FOR CERTAIN MOTOR
14	VEHICLES. (a) At the time of registration or reregistration of
15	the motor vehicle, the department shall issue a specially designed
16	"hybrid vehicle" insignia for a motor vehicle that draws propulsion
17	energy from a rechargeable energy storage system, either alone or
18	along with gasoline or conventional diesel fuel.

- 1 registered is a vehicle described by Subsection (a).
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
