## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT 1 2 relating to the registration of voters at a polling place and 3 related procedures. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 62, Election Code, is amended by adding Section 62.0015 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 62.0015. VOTER REGISTRARS MUST BE PRESENT. Two voter 7 registrars must be present at each polling place while the polls are 8 9 open. SECTION 2. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding 10 11 Section 63.010 to read as follows: 12 Sec. 63.010. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE; VOTING 13 PROCEDURES. (a) Other applicable provisions of this code apply to 14 the conduct of voting and to the registration of voters under this section to the extent those provisions do not conflict with this 15 16 section. (b) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election 17 18 under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered voter, shall be accepted for voting in the precinct of the person's 19 residence if, on the day the person offers to vote, the person: 20 (1) submits a voter registration application that 21 22 complies with Section 13.002 to a voter registrar at the polling 23 place; and 24 (2) presents as proof of identification:

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(A) a Texas driver's license, including a 1 temporary license or instruction permit, or personal 2 identification card issued to the person by the Department of 3 Public Safety that states the person's current address on the day 4 5 the person seeks to vote; or 6 (B) a utility bill addressed to the person dated not earlier than the 30th day before the date the person seeks to 7 8 vote, and: 9 (i) a Texas driver's license, including a temporary license or instruction permit, or personal 10 identification card issued to the person by the Department of 11 Public Safety, regardless of whether the address stated on the 12 license or card is current on the day the person seeks to vote; 13 14 (ii) a United States passport issued to the 15 person; or (iii) a United States military 16 17 identification card that contains the person's photograph. (c) Persons voting under this section shall be processed 18 separately at the polling place from persons who are voting under 19 regular procedures. 20 21 (d) The secretary of state shall adopt rules to ensure the accountability of election officers and to fairly implement this 22 23 section. 24 SECTION 3. The secretary of state shall adopt rules as required by Section 63.010, Election Code, as added by this Act, not 25 later than February 1, 2010. 26 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 27

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1	an election for which early voting by personal appearance begins	on
2	or after February 1, 2010.	

3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
