1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the expansion of the financial literacy pilot program
1-9 in public schools.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 29.915, Education Code, is amended by
1-12 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
1-13 follows:

1-14 (d) The agency shall develop an application and selection
1-15 process for selecting school districts to participate in the
1-16 program. The agency may select not more than 100 [~~25~~] school
1-17 districts to participate in the program.

1-18 (f) Not later than January 1, 2011, the agency shall provide
1-19 each member of the legislature with a report relating to the
1-20 implementation and effectiveness of the program. This subsection
1-21 expires February 1, 2011.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
