## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 160.607, Family Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A proceeding seeking to disprove the father-child
- 8 relationship between a child and the child's presumed father may be
- 9 maintained at any time if the court determines that:
- 10 (1) the presumed father and the mother of the child did
- 11 not live together or engage in sexual intercourse with each other
- 12 during the probable time of conception [+] and
- 13  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  the presumed father never represented to others
- 14 that the child was his own; or
- 15 (2) the presumed father was precluded from commencing
- 16 a proceeding to adjudicate the parentage of the child before the
- 17 <u>expiration of the time prescribed by Subsection (a) because another</u>
- 18 person fraudulently led him to believe he was the father of the
- 19 <u>child</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a proceeding to adjudicate parentage that is commenced on or
- 22 after the effective date of this Act. A proceeding to adjudicate
- 23 parentage commenced before that date is governed by the law in
- 24 effect on the date the proceeding was commenced, and the former law

- 1 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
