## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to prohibiting a restrictive covenant granting a right of 2 first refusal to a property owners' association in certain 3 4 circumstances. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding 6 Section 202.008 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 202.008. RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL PROHIBITED. (a) In 8 this section, "development period" means a period stated in a 9 declaration during which a declarant reserves: 10 (1) a right to facilitate the development, 11 12 construction, and marketing of the subdivision; 13 (2) a right to direct the size, shape, and composition 14 of the subdivision; or (3) any other right customarily reserved by a 15 16 declarant for the benefit of developers and builders. (b) To the extent a restrictive covenant provides a right of 17 first refusal for the sale or lease of a residential unit or 18 residential lot in favor of the property owners' association or the 19 association's members, the covenant is void. 20 21 (c) This section does not apply to a restrictive covenant that provides a right of first refusal in favor of a developer or 22 23 builder during the development period. 24 SECTION 2. Section 202.008, Property Code, as added by this

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S.B. No. 235 1 Act, applies to a deed restriction enacted before, on, or after the 2 effective date of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
