- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 38.026 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 38.026. GRANT PROGRAM FOR BEST PRACTICES IN NUTRITION
- 8 EDUCATION. (a) The Department of Agriculture shall develop a
- 9 program under which the department awards grants to public school
- 10 campuses for best practices in nutrition education.
- 11 (b) The Department of Agriculture may solicit and accept
- 12 gifts, grants, and donations from any public or private source for
- 13 the purposes of this section.
- 14 (c) The Department of Agriculture may adopt rules as
- 15 necessary to administer a grant program established under this
- 16 section.
- 17 SECTION 2. Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Section 33.028 to read as follows:
- 19 <u>Sec. 33.028. GRANT PROGRAMS FOR NUTRITION EDUCATION. (a)</u>
- 20 The Department of Agriculture shall develop a program under which
- 21 the department awards grants to:
- 22 (1) participants in the Child and Adult Care Food
- 23 Program, Head Start program, or other early childhood education
- 24 programs to operate nutrition education programs for children who

- 1 are at least three years of age but younger than five years of age;
- 2 and
- 3 (2) community and faith-based initiatives that
- 4 provide recreational, social, volunteer, leadership, mentoring, or
- 5 developmental programs to incorporate nutrition education into
- 6 programs provided for children younger than 19 years of age.
- 7 (b) The Department of Agriculture may solicit and accept
- 8 gifts, grants, and donations from any public or private source for
- 9 the purposes of this section.
- 10 <u>(c) The Department of Agriculture may adopt rules as</u>
- 11 necessary to administer the grant programs established under this
- 12 section.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
