A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the membership and activities of local school health 3 advisory councils. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 28.004, Education Code, is amended by 5 6 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (d-1), (m), (m-1), 7 and (m-2) to read as follows: (d) The board of trustees shall appoint members to the 8 council. A majority of the members must be persons who are parents 9 of students enrolled in the district and who are not employed by the 10 11 district. The board of trustees shall appoint one of those members 12 to serve as chair or co-chair of the council and may appoint both a 13 chair and co-chair from among those members. The board of trustees 14 also may appoint one or more persons from each of the following groups or a representative from a group other than a group specified 15 under this subsection: 16 public school teachers; 17 (1)18 (2) public school administrators; district students; 19 (3) health care professionals; 20 (4)21 (5) the business community; 22 (6) law enforcement; 23 (7) senior citizens;

(8) the clergy; and

1 (9) nonprofit health organizations. 2 (d-1) The local school health advisory council shall meet at 3 least four times each year. 4 (m) In addition to performing other duties, the local school 5 health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees, at 6 least annually, a written report that includes: 7 (1) any council recommendation concerning the school 8 district's health education curriculum and instruction or related 9 matters that the council has not previously submitted to the board; 10 (2) any suggested modification to a council recommendation previously submitted to the board; and 11 12 (3) a detailed explanation of the council's activities during the period between the date of the current report and the 13 14 date of the last prior written report. 15 (m-1) In lieu of the report that otherwise would be required under Subsection (m), not later than April 1, 2010, the local school 16 17 health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees an initial written report that includes: 18 19 (1) any information required under Subsections (m)(1) and (2); and 20 21 (2) a detailed explanation of the council's activities during the 12-month period preceding the date of the report. 22 (m-2) Subsection (m-1) and this subsection expire April 30, 23

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
