1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the membership and activities of local school health  
1-11 advisory councils.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 28.004, Education Code, is amended by  
1-14 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (d-1), (m), (m-1),  
1-15 and (m-2) to read as follows:

1-16 (d) The board of trustees shall appoint members to the local  
1-17 school health advisory council. A majority of the members must be  
1-18 persons who are parents of students enrolled in the district and who  
1-19 are not employed by the district. One of those members shall  
1-20 serve as chair or co-chair of the council. The board of trustees  
1-21 also may appoint one or more persons from each of the following  
1-22 groups or a representative from a group other than a group specified  
1-23 under this subsection:

- 1-24 (1) public school teachers;
- 1-25 (2) public school administrators;
- 1-26 (3) district students;
- 1-27 (4) health care professionals;
- 1-28 (5) the business community;
- 1-29 (6) law enforcement;
- 1-30 (7) senior citizens;
- 1-31 (8) the clergy; and
- 1-32 (9) nonprofit health organizations.

1-33 (d-1) The local school health advisory council shall meet at  
1-34 least four times each year.

1-35 (m) In addition to performing other duties, the local school  
1-36 health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees, at  
1-37 least annually, a written report that includes:

1-38 (1) any council recommendation concerning the school  
1-39 district's health education curriculum and instruction or related  
1-40 matters that the council has not previously submitted to the board;

1-41 (2) any suggested modification to a council  
1-42 recommendation previously submitted to the board; and

1-43 (3) a detailed explanation of the council's activities  
1-44 during the period between the date of the current report and the  
1-45 date of the last prior written report.

1-46 (m-1) In lieu of the report that otherwise would be required  
1-47 under Subsection (m), not later than April 1, 2010, the local school  
1-48 health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees an  
1-49 initial written report that includes:

1-50 (1) any information required under Subsections (m)(1)  
1-51 and (2); and

1-52 (2) a detailed explanation of the council's activities  
1-53 during the 12-month period preceding the date of the report.

1-54 (m-2) Subsection (m-1) and this subsection expire April 30,  
1-55 2010.

1-56 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
