- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 311, Transportation Code, 6 is amended by adding Section 311.054 to read as follows:
- Sec. 311.054. RAILROAD QUIET ZONE LOCATED OUTSIDE TYPE A

 8 GENERAL-LAW MUNICIPALITY. (a) This section applies only to a Type

 9 A general-law municipality that is an enclave surrounded entirely

 10 by a municipality with a population of 1.1 million or more.
- 11 (b) The governing body of the general-law municipality may

 12 enter into an interlocal contract with the surrounding municipality

 13 for the establishment of a railroad quiet zone located outside the

 14 boundaries of the general-law municipality that the governing body

 15 determines will benefit the general-law municipality.
- 16 (c) A general-law municipality may expend municipal funds

 17 and may issue certificates of obligation or bonds to pay for

 18 expenses associated with a railroad quiet zone under Subsection

 19 (b), including expenses related to feasibility, engineering, and

 20 traffic studies and improvements related to the railroad quiet

 21 zone.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
