12 practicable, offer to school districts and public school campuses seminars or conferences to train and assist teachers in providing 13 <u>instruction</u> in <u>personal</u> <u>financial lite</u>racy as required under 14 15 Section 28.0021. The governing board of the institution that

provides the seminar or conference shall charge the district an 16 17 amount equal to the cost to the institution of providing the seminar

or conference.
