1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the designation of a segment of Interstate Highway 30 in  
1-9 Hunt County as the Martin Luther King, Jr., Freeway.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-12 is amended by adding Section 225.079 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 225.079. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., FREEWAY IN HUNT  
1-14 COUNTY. (a) The part of Interstate Highway 30 in the corporate  
1-15 limits of the city of Greenville is designated as the Martin Luther  
1-16 King, Jr., Freeway.

1-17 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall  
1-18 design and construct memorial markers indicating the freeway  
1-19 number, the designation as the Martin Luther King, Jr., Freeway,  
1-20 and any other appropriate information. The department shall erect  
1-21 a marker at each end of the freeway and at appropriate intermediate  
1-22 sites along the freeway.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
