2-2 SECTION 2. INAPPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN LAW. Chapter 2110,
2-3 Government Code, does not apply to the advisory committee
2-4 established under this Act.

2-5 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. The advisory committee established 2-6 under this Act is abolished and this Act expires September 1, 2011.

2-7 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 2-8 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 2-9 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 2-10 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 2-11 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
