A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the frequency and content of school bus emergency 3 evacuation training.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 34.0021, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1) 7 to read as follows:

8 (a) Pursuant to the safety standards established by the 9 Department of Public Safety under Section 34.002, each school 10 district shall conduct a training session for <u>school bus passengers</u> 11 [students and teachers] concerning procedures for evacuating a 12 school bus during an emergency.

(b) A school district shall conduct <u>a</u> [the] school bus emergency evacuation training <u>session</u> [at least twice each school year, with one training session occurring] in the fall <u>of each</u> <u>school year</u> [and one training session occurring in the spring]. A portion of the training session must occur on a school bus and the training session must last for at least one hour.

19 <u>(c-1) Immediately before each field trip involving</u> 20 <u>transportation by school bus, a school district shall review school</u> 21 <u>bus emergency evacuation procedures with the school bus passengers,</u> 22 <u>including a demonstration of the school bus emergency exits and the</u> 23 <u>safe manner to exit.</u>

(d) Not later than the 30th day after the date that a school

district completes <u>the</u> [a] training session <u>required by Subsection</u>
(b), the district shall provide the Department of Public Safety
with a record certifying the district's completion of the training.

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010 5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
