- 2 relating to the administrative fine and the late payment fee for a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 411.067(a), (b), and (d), Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department may [shall have authority to] adopt rules
- 8 for the assessment of an administrative fine of $\frac{$25}{}$ [\$10] for
- 9 violations of the parking rules adopted under Section 411.063.
- 10 Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 411.065 and 411.066, the
- 11 department may [in its discretion] issue an administrative citation
- 12 for a parking violation.
- 13 (b) Rules adopted under this section shall:
- 14 (1) establish a system for enforcement of
- 15 administrative citations, including [but not limited to]
- 16 assessment of a late fee not to exceed \$5 [\$2] and towing,
- impoundment, or immobilization of vehicles; and
- 18 (2) provide [for] a procedure of administrative review
- 19 within the highway patrol district that includes the Capitol
- 20 Complex [capitol police district] and, on request of the person
- 21 assessed an administrative fine, further judicial review by the
- 22 department filing the appropriate citation or complaint in a court
- 23 [of competent jurisdiction], as provided in Section 411.066.
- 24 (d) The department shall remit to the comptroller for

- 1 deposit in the general revenue fund \underline{each} [\underline{any}] administrative fine
- 2 <u>and late fee collected</u> [received] under this section. The money
- 3 <u>deposited</u> [Such revenues] may be appropriated only to the
- 4 department for [capitol police] security and parking in the highway
- 5 patrol district that includes the Capitol Complex.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
