1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the administrative fine and the late payment fee for a  
1-9 violation of a parking rule applicable to the Capitol Complex.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), and (d), Section 411.067,  
1-12 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) The department may ~~[shall have authority to]~~ adopt rules  
1-14 for the assessment of an administrative fine of \$25 ~~[\$10]~~ for  
1-15 violations of the parking rules adopted under Section 411.063.  
1-16 Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 411.065 and 411.066, the  
1-17 department may ~~[in its discretion]~~ issue an administrative citation  
1-18 for a parking violation.

1-19 (b) Rules adopted under this section shall:

1-20 (1) establish a system for enforcement of  
1-21 administrative citations, including ~~[but not limited to]~~  
1-22 assessment of a late fee not to exceed \$5 ~~[\$2]~~ and towing,  
1-23 impoundment, or immobilization of vehicles; and

1-24 (2) provide ~~[for]~~ a procedure of administrative review  
1-25 within the highway patrol district that includes the Capitol  
1-26 Complex ~~[capitol police district]~~ and, on request of the person  
1-27 assessed an administrative fine, further judicial review by the  
1-28 department filing the appropriate citation or complaint in a court  
1-29 ~~[of competent jurisdiction]~~, as provided in Section 411.066.

1-30 (d) The department shall remit to the comptroller for  
1-31 deposit in the general revenue fund each ~~[any]~~ administrative fine  
1-32 and late fee collected ~~[received]~~ under this section. The money  
1-33 deposited ~~[Such revenues]~~ may be appropriated only to the  
1-34 department for ~~[capitol police]~~ security and parking in the highway  
1-35 patrol district that includes the Capitol Complex.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
