5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 411.0207 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 411.0207. PUBLIC CORRUPTION UNIT. (a) In this
8	section, "organized criminal activity" means conduct that
9	constitutes an offense under Section 71.02, Penal Code.
10	(b) A public corruption unit is created within the
11	department to investigate and assist in the management of
12	allegations of participation in organized criminal activity by:
13	(1) an individual elected, appointed, or employed to
14	serve as a peace officer for a governmental entity of this state
15	under Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure; or
16	(2) a federal law enforcement officer while performing
17	duties in this state.
18	(c) The unit shall:
19	(1) assist district attorneys and county attorneys in

- (2) if requested by the agency, assist a state or local 22

- 19 (e) To the extent allowed by law, a state or local law

- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2010, the Department

- 1 by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
