- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 12.02, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Art. 12.02. MISDEMEANORS. (a) An indictment or
- 7 information for any Class A or Class B misdemeanor may be presented
- 8 within two years from the date of the commission of the offense, and
- 9 not afterward.
- 10 (b) A complaint or information for any Class C misdemeanor
- 11 may be presented within two years from the date of the commission of
- 12 the offense, and not afterward.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by Article 12.02, Code of
- 14 Criminal Procedure, as amended by this Act, does not apply to an
- 15 offense if the prosecution of that offense became barred by
- 16 limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution
- 17 of that offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
