10	defendant in the judgment in a felony or misdemeanor criminal case;
11	(2) [amount of] reimbursement for costs of:
12	(A) confinement ordered under Article 42.038; or
13	(B) notice provided under Article 62.056 or
14	62.201; and
15	(3) [amount of] damages incurred by the state as a
16	result of the commission of an offense under Section 38.04, Penal
17	Code, in which the defendant used a motor vehicle while the
18	defendant was in flight.
19	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
20	to a judgment in a criminal case for an offense committed on or
21	after the effective date of this Act. A judgment in a criminal case
22	for an offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
23	governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
24	the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For

- 1 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 2 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 3 before that date.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
