- SECTION 2. Section 1305.102, Occupations Code, is amended
- 17 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 18 (d) The commission may adopt rules regarding the
- 19 registration of apprenticeship training programs and to require
- 20 registered programs to report the names of persons enrolled in the
- 21 programs.
- 22 SECTION 3. Section 1305.168, Occupations Code, is amended
- 23 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 24 follows:

- 1 (b) Continuing education courses that satisfy the
- 2 requirements of <u>Subsection (a)</u> [this section] must address <u>safety</u>,
- 3 the National Electrical Code, as adopted under Section 1305.101,
- 4 and state laws and rules that regulate the conduct of license
- 5 holders under this chapter.
- 6 (b-1) To renew an electrical apprentice license, a license
- 7 holder who is not enrolled in an apprenticeship training program
- 8 must complete four hours of continuing education annually.
- 9 Continuing education courses that satisfy the requirements of this
- 10 subsection must address safety, the National Electrical Code, as
- 11 adopted under Section 1305.101, and state laws and rules that
- 12 regulate the conduct of license holders under this chapter.
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 14 renewal of an electrical apprentice license that expires on or
- 15 after September 1, 2010. A license that expires before September 1,
- 16 2010, is governed by the law in effect on the date the license was
- 17 issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
