A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of the Texas Transportation Commission to
3	enter into a covenant for environmental remediation of real
4	property owned by the Texas Department of Transportation.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 202, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 202.061 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 202.061. ENVIRONMENTAL COVENANT. (a) The commission
9	may enter into an environmental covenant for the purpose of
10	subjecting real property in which the department has an ownership
11	interest to a plan or the performance of work for environmental
12	remediation if the plan or work performed is first approved by the
13	Texas Commission on Environmental Quality or a federal agency with
14	the authority to approve the plan or work under the applicable laws
15	and regulations.
16	(b) The environmental covenant must:
17	(1) contain a legally sufficient description of the
18	<pre>property subject to the covenant;</pre>
19	(2) describe the nature of the contamination on or
20	under the property, including the contaminants, the source, if
21	known, and the location and extent of the contamination; and
22	(3) describe the activity and use limitations on the
23	property.
24	(c) The plan or performance of work for environmental

1 remediation must:

- 2 (1) meet applicable state and federal standards for
- 3 environmental remediation; and
- 4 (2) bring the property into compliance with zoning or
- 5 land use controls imposed on the property by each applicable local
- 6 government.
- 7 (d) For each property for which the commission may enter
- 8 into an environmental covenant, the commission by order may
- 9 <u>authorize the executive director to execute an environmental</u>
- 10 covenant on behalf of the commission. Not less than 30 days before
- 11 the date the commission considers a proposed order under this
- 12 subsection, the commission must mail to each owner of a property
- 13 interest in the applicable property, each adjacent landowner, and
- 14 each applicable local government a notice that includes a clear and
- 15 concise description of the proposal to enter into the environmental
- 16 covenant and a statement of the manner in which written comments may
- 17 <u>be submitted to the commission.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
