4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.428 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.428. VULNERABLE ROAD USERS. (a) In this section,
8	"vulnerable road user" means:
9	(1) a pedestrian, including a runner, physically
10	disabled person, child, skater, highway construction and
11	maintenance worker, tow truck operator, utility worker, other
12	worker with legitimate business in or near the road or
13	right-of-way, or stranded motorist or passenger;
14	(2) a person on horseback;
15	(3) a person operating equipment other than a motor
16	vehicle, including a bicycle, handcycle, horse-driven conveyance,
17	or unprotected farm equipment; or
18	(4) a person operating a motorcycle, moped,
19	motor-driven cycle, or motor-assisted scooter.
20	(b) An operator of a motor vehicle passing a vulnerable road
21	user operating on a highway or street shall:
22	(1) vacate the lane in which the vulnerable road user
23	is located if the highway has two or more marked lanes running in

1	(2) pass the vulnerable road user at a safe distance.
2	(c) For the purposes of Subsection (b)(2), the operator is
3	presumed to have failed to comply with Subsection (b)(2) if the
4	distance between the operator's vehicle and the vulnerable road
5	user is less than:
6	(1) three feet if the operator's vehicle is a passenger
7	<u>car or light truck; or</u>
8	(2) six feet if the operator's vehicle is a truck other
9	than a light truck or a commercial motor vehicle as defined by
10	Section 522.003.
11	(d) An operator of a motor vehicle that is making a left turn
12	at an intersection, including an intersection with an alley or
13	private road or driveway, shall yield the right-of-way to a
14	vulnerable road user who is approaching from the opposite direction
15	and is in the intersection or in such proximity to the intersection
16	as to be an immediate hazard.
17	(e) An operator of a motor vehicle may not overtake a
18	vulnerable road user traveling in the same direction and
19	subsequently make a right-hand turn in front of the vulnerable road
20	user unless the operator is safely clear of the vulnerable road
21	user, taking into account the speed at which the vulnerable road
22	user is traveling and the braking requirements of the vehicle

24	(f) An operator of a motor vehicle may not maneuver the
25	vehicle in a manner that:
26	(1) is intended to cause intimidation or harassment to

1	(2) threatens a vulnerable road user.
2	(g) An operator of a motor vehicle shall exercise due care
3	to avoid colliding with any vulnerable road user on a roadway or in
4	an intersection of roadways.
5	(h) A person may not open the door on the side of a vehicle
6	that is adjacent to moving traffic unless it is reasonably safe to
7	open the door without interfering with the movement of traffic,
8	including vulnerable road users. A person may not leave a door open
9	on the side of a vehicle that is adjacent to moving traffic for a
10	period longer than necessary to load or unload passengers or goods.
11	(i) A person may not harass, taunt, or throw an object or
12	liquid at or in the direction of any vulnerable road user.
13	(j) A violation of this section is punishable under Section
14	542.401 except that:
15	(1) if the violation results in property damage, the
16	violation is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not to exceed
17	\$500; or
18	(2) if the violation results in bodily injury, the
19	violation is a Class B misdemeanor.
20	(k) The presumption provided by Subsection (c) does not
21	arise and may not be applied against the operator of the motor
22	vehicle if at the time of the offense the vulnerable road user was
23	acting in violation of the law.
24	(1) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
25	also constitutes an offense under another section of this code or
26	the Penal Code, the actor may be prosecuted under either section or
27	both sections.
