## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the powers, duties, and financing of cultural education
- 3 facilities finance corporations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3(5), Cultural Education Facilities
- 6 Finance Corporation Act (Article 1528m, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 7 Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (5) "Cultural facility" means <u>any capital expenditure</u>
- 9 by a user. The term includes:
- 10 (A) real property or an interest in real
- 11 property, including buildings and improvements, or equipment,
- 12 furnishings, or other personal property that:
- 13 (i) is found by the board to be necessary or
- 14 convenient to finance, refinance, acquire, construct, enlarge,
- 15 remodel, renovate, improve, furnish, or equip for cultural
- 16 education or community benefit;
- 17 (ii) is made available for use by the
- 18 general public, the user, or community groups; and
- 19 (iii) is used for a purpose described by
- 20 Section 2(a)(1) of this Act; and
- 21 (B) facilities incidental, subordinate, or
- 22 related to or appropriate in connection with property described by
- 23 Paragraph (A) of this subdivision, located within the state,
- 24 regardless of the date of construction or acquisition.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 4(b), Cultural Education Facilities
- 2 Finance Corporation Act (Article 1528m, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 3 Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) The corporation shall be created and organized in the
- 5 same manner as a health facilities development corporation under
- 6 Chapter 221, Health and Safety Code, and has the same powers,
- 7 authority, and rights:
- 8 (1) with respect to cultural facilities and health
- 9 facilities that a health facilities development corporation has
- 10 with respect to health facilities under Chapter 221, Health and
- 11 Safety Code; and
- 12 (2) with respect to educational facilities, housing
- 13 facilities, and other facilities incidental, subordinate, or
- 14 related to those facilities that a nonprofit corporation created
- under Section 53.35(b), Education Code, or an authority created
- 16 under Section 53.11, Education Code, has under Chapter 53,
- 17 Education Code.
- 18 SECTION 3. The Cultural Education Facilities Finance
- 19 Corporation Act (Article 1528m, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) is
- amended by adding Section 4B to read as follows:
- Sec. 4B. AUTHORIZATION TO FINANCE ACTIVITIES. This Act
- 22 authorizes the following entities to finance any activity in which
- 23 the entity is permitted to engage:
- 24 (1) a nonprofit corporation exempt from the state
- 25 franchise tax under Section 171.063, Tax Code;
- 26 (2) an organization that qualifies as a charitable
- organization under Section 11.18, Tax Code; or

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- 1 (3) an organization described in Section 501(c)(3),
- 2 <u>Internal Revenue Code of 1986.</u>
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
