## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain mammography systems that fail certification
- 3 standards.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 401.430(f), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (f) If a facility's mammography system fails to meet the
- 8 department's certification standards and the failure is a Severity
- 9 Level I violation under the department's rules, the facility shall
- 10 notify each patient on whom the facility performed a mammography
- 11 during the period in which the system failed to meet the
- 12 <u>department's certification standards</u> [30 days preceding the date of
- 13 the inspection that revealed the failure]. The facility shall:
- 14 (1) inform the patient that the mammography system
- 15 failed to satisfy the department's certification standards;
- 16 (2) recommend that the patient consult with the
- 17 patient's physician regarding the need for another mammogram [have
- 18 another mammogram performed at a facility with a certified
- 19 mammography system]; and
- 20 (3) list the three facilities closest to the original
- 21 testing facility that have a certified mammography system.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
