Sections 151.801(c) and (c-1), Tax Code, are 18 amended to read as follows: 19 Subject to Subsection (c-1), the proceeds from the 20 (c) 21 collection of the taxes imposed by this chapter on the sale, storage, or use of sporting goods shall be deposited as follows: 22 (1) an amount equal to 74 [94] percent of the proceeds 23 shall be credited to the Parks and Wildlife Department and 24

deposited as specified in the Parks and Wildlife Code; [and] 1 2 (2) an amount equal to six percent of the proceeds shall be credited to the Texas Historical Commission and deposited 3 4 as specified in Section 442.073, Government Code; and 5 (3) an amount equal to 20 percent of the proceeds shall 6 be credited to the General Land Office and deposited as specified in Section 33.604, Natural Resources Code. 7 (c-1) The comptroller may not credit to the Parks and 8 9 Wildlife Department, [or] the Texas Historical Commission, or the General Land Office any amounts under this section that are in 10 excess of the amounts appropriated to the department, [or] 11 commission, or office for that biennium, less any other amounts to 12 which the department, [or] commission, or office is entitled. 13

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
