8	Sec. 100B.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Child" means a person younger than 18 years of

11	(2) "Criminal street gang" means three or more persons
12	having a common identifying sign or symbol or an identifiable
13	leadership who continuously or regularly associate in the
14	commission of criminal activities.
15	(3) "Continuously or regularly" means at least five
16	times in a period of not more than 12 months.
17	(4) "Gang activity" has the meaning assigned by
18	Section 125.061.
19	(5) "Governmental entity" means:
20	(A) this state and any agency of the state; and
21	(B) a political subdivision of this state,
22	including any city, county, school district, junior college
23	district, levee improvement district, drainage district,
24	irrigation district, water improvement district, water control and

1 improvement district, water control and preservation district, freshwater supply district, navigation district, conservation and 2 reclamation district, soil conservation district, communication 3 district, public health district, and river authority. 4 (6) "Parent" means a natural or adoptive parent, 5 managing or possessory conservator, or legal guardian of a person. 6 7 [Sections 100B.002-100B.050 reserved for expansion] SUBCHAPTER B. LIABILITY TO PARENT 8 Sec. 100B.051. LIABILITY. A criminal street gang or a 9 10 member of a criminal street gang is liable to the parent of a child for damages arising from the criminal street gang's or a member of 11 12 the criminal street gang's recruitment or inducement of the child to become a member of the criminal street gang. 13 Sec. 100B.052. DAMAGES. (a) A plaintiff who prevails in a 14 15 suit under this chapter may recover economic and noneconomic damages, including damages for loss of companionship of and society 16 with the child and mental anguish, even if an injury other than 17 mental anguish is not shown. 18 19 (b) In addition to an award under Subsection (a), a plaintiff who prevails in a suit under this chapter may recover 20 exemplary damages and court costs and reasonable attorney's fees. 21 22 [Sections 100B.053-100B.100 reserved for expansion] SUBCHAPTER C. LIABILITY TO GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY 23 Sec. 100B.101. LIABILITY. A criminal street gang or a 24 member of a criminal street gang is liable to a governmental entity 25 26 for damages arising from activities of a criminal street gang, 27 including:

<u>Sec. 100B.201. LEVY ON PROPERTY OF GANG OR MEMBER. The</u>
<u>property of the criminal street gang or a member of the street gang</u>
<u>may be seized in execution on a judgment under this section.</u>

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that accrued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
