S.B. No. 552

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to funding for the continuing education of certain peace
- 3 officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 1701.157,
- 6 Occupations Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Not later than March 1 of each calendar year, the
- 8 comptroller shall allocate money deposited during the preceding
- 9 calendar year in the general revenue fund to the credit of the law
- 10 enforcement officer standards and education fund account for
- 11 expenses related to the continuing education of persons licensed
- 12 under this chapter as follows:
- 13 (1) 20 percent of the money is allocated to [all] local
- 14 law enforcement agencies in this state that meet the eligibility
- 15 requirements described by Subsection (b) in equal shares; and
- 16 (2) 80 percent of the money is allocated to [all] local
- 17 law enforcement agencies in this state that meet the eligibility
- 18 requirements described by Subsection (b) in a share representing a
- 19 fixed amount for each position in the agency, as of January 1 of the
- 20 preceding calendar year, that is reserved to a person who:
- 21 (A) is licensed under this chapter;
- (B) works as a peace officer on the average of at
- 23 least 32 hours a week; and
- 24 (C) is compensated by a political subdivision of

- 1 this state at least at the minimum wage and is entitled to all
- 2 employee benefits offered to a peace officer by the political
- 3 subdivision.
- 4 (b) To be eligible for an allocation of money under
- 5 Subsection (a), a [Not later than November 1 of each calendar year,
- 6 each] local law enforcement agency must [shall] report to the
- 7 comptroller not later than November 1 of the preceding calendar
- 8 year:
- 9 (1) the number of agency positions described by
- 10 Subsection (a)(2) reserved as of January 1 of the [that] year the
- 11 report is due;
- 12 (2) the number of agency positions described by
- 13 Subsection (a)(2) filled as of January 1 of the year the report is
- 14 due;
- 15 (3) the percentage of the money received by the agency
- 16 under Subsection (a) pursuant to the allocation made by the
- 17 comptroller on or before March 1 of the year preceding the year in
- 18 which the report is due that was used by the agency before the date
- 19 of the allocation made by the comptroller under Subsection (a) on or
- 20 before March 1 of the year the report is due;
- 21 (4) the number of training hours received during the
- 22 12-month or approximately 12-month period described by Subdivision
- 23 (3) that were funded by money received by the agency pursuant to the
- 24 allocation made by the comptroller on or before March 1 of the year
- 25 preceding the year in which the report is due; and
- 26 (5) that the agency has complied with the requirements
- 27 of this section regarding the use of any money received by the

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- 1 agency pursuant to the allocation made by the comptroller on or
- 2 before March 1 of the year preceding the year in which the report is
- $3 \quad \underline{\text{due}}$.
- 4 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 5 1701.157, Occupations Code, apply to allocations made on or after
- 6 January 1, 2011. Allocations made before that date are governed by
- 7 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 8 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
