- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 31.01, Tax Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (f) and (i-1), the
- 9 assessor for each taxing unit shall prepare and mail a tax bill to
- 10 each person in whose name the property is listed on the tax roll and
- 11 to the person's authorized agent. The assessor shall mail tax bills
- 12 by October 1 or as soon thereafter as practicable. The assessor
- 13 shall mail to the state agency or institution the tax bill for any
- 14 taxable property owned by the agency or institution. The agency or
- 15 institution shall pay the taxes from funds appropriated for payment
- 16 of the taxes or, if there are none, from funds appropriated for the
- 17 administration of the agency or institution. The exterior of the
- 18 tax bill must show the return address of the taxing unit. If the
- 19 assessor wants the United States Postal Service to return the tax
- 20 bill if it is not deliverable as addressed, the exterior of the tax
- 21 bill may [and must] contain, in all capital letters, the words
- 22 "RETURN SERVICE REQUESTED," or another appropriate statement
- 23 directing the United States Postal Service to return the tax bill if
- 24 it is not deliverable as addressed.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
