1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the course levels offered by the University of  
1-9 Houston-Victoria.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 111.96, Education Code, is amended to  
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 111.96. ESTABLISHMENT: SCOPE. (a) The board of  
1-14 regents shall maintain ~~establish~~ an ~~upper-level~~ educational  
1-15 institution in the City of Victoria to be known as the University of  
1-16 Houston-Victoria.

1-17 (b) The institution shall ~~[be organized to]~~ offer  
1-18 undergraduate ~~[only junior, senior,]~~ and graduate level programs.

1-19 ~~[(c) The institution may enroll a student who has~~  
1-20 ~~successfully completed at least 30 semester credit hours of course~~  
1-21 ~~work at a public or private institution of higher education and who~~  
1-22 ~~is concurrently enrolled in another public or private institution~~  
1-23 ~~of higher education.]~~

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
