- 13 <u>facility whose chronological or developmental age is younger than</u>
- 14 <u>nine years of age to complete at least two hours of annual training</u>
- 15 on transportation safety.
- 16 SECTION 3. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 17 Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules required by
- 18 Subsection (e), Section 42.0421, Human Resources Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, not later than March 1, 2010.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
