1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the time for dissolution of crime control and  
1-9 prevention districts.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 363.301, Local  
1-12 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) The district is dissolved on the first uniform election  
1-14 date that occurs after the fifth anniversary of the date the  
1-15 district began to levy taxes for district purposes if the district  
1-16 has not held a continuation or dissolution referendum.

1-17 (b) The district is dissolved on the first uniform election  
1-18 date that occurs after the fifth anniversary of the date of the most  
1-19 recent continuation or dissolution referendum.

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
