- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1302.453(b), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) It is an exception to the application of this section
- 8 with respect to a purchase of a refrigerant or equipment containing
- 9 a refrigerant in this state in violation of Section 1302.356(1)
- 10 $[\frac{1302.356}{}]$ that:
- 11 (1) the refrigerant or equipment is purchased for use
- 12 in a commercial or residential air conditioning system that
- 13 requires 15 pounds or less of refrigerant; or
- 14 (2) the refrigerant or equipment is purchased for use
- 15 only in a motor vehicle and that use is authorized by the United
- 16 States Environmental Protection Agency.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 22 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 23 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
