## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax for certain renewable
- 3 energy devices and manufacturing equipment.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.318, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (u) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(u) In addition to the other items exempted under this</u>
- 8 section, all equipment necessary for the production or manufacture
- 9 of photovoltaic renewable energy devices, including equipment
- 10 described by Subsections (c) and (e), is exempted from the taxes
- 11 imposed by this chapter. In this subsection, "photovoltaic
- 12 renewable energy device" means a device and related components that
- 13 naturally generate or regenerate over a short period electric
- 14 energy that is derived directly or indirectly from the sun.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 16 by adding Section 151.3332 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 151.3332. PHOTOVOLTAIC RENEWABLE ENERGY DEVICES. (a)
- 18 <u>In this section:</u>

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- 19 (1) "Photovoltaic renewable energy device" has the
- 20 meaning assigned by Section 151.318(u).
- 21 (2) "Retail customer" has the meaning assigned by
- 22 Section 31.002, Utilities Code.
- 23 (b) The sale, use, installation, construction, assembly,
- 24 maintenance, or other consumption of a photovoltaic renewable

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- 1 energy device that is connected or placed on a retail customer's
- 2 side of the meter is exempted from the taxes imposed by this
- 3 <u>chapter.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 5 affect a tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 6 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 7 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 8 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 9 the liability for those taxes.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009, if it
- 11 receives a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house,
- 12 as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that date,
- 14 this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
