- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 262.0271(b), Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) In purchasing items under this chapter through a
- 9 competitive bidding process, if a county receives one or more bids
- 10 from a bidder who provides reasonable [comparable] health insurance
- 11 coverage to its employees and requires a subcontractor the bidder
- 12 intends to use to provide reasonable [comparable] health insurance
- 13 coverage to the subcontractor's employees and whose bid is within
- 14 10 [five] percent of the lowest bid price received by the county
- 15 from a bidder who does not provide or require <u>reasonable</u>
- 16 [comparable] health insurance coverage, the commissioners court of
- 17 the county may give preference to the bidder who provides and
- 18 requires <u>reasonable</u> [comparable] health insurance coverage.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 262.0271(a), Local Government Code, is
- 20 repealed.
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a contract awarded on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
