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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the use of net metering by certain electric utilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 39.107, Utilities Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (i), as added by Chapter 939 (H.B. 3693), Acts 6 of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, and adding 7 Subsection (k) to read as follows:

8 (i) Subject to the restrictions in Subsection (h), it is the 9 intent of the legislature that [net metering and] advanced meter 10 information networks be deployed as rapidly as possible to allow 11 customers to better manage energy use and control costs, and to 12 facilitate demand response initiatives.

13 (k) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall 14 adopt rules and standards under which a retail electric provider, 15 electric cooperative, municipally owned utility, or transmission 16 and distribution utility shall offer net metering service as 17 defined by the federal Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 18 <u>1978 (16 U.S.C. Section 2621(d)(11)) to all residential customers</u> 19 as soon as practicable but not later than January 1, 2010.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
