22	Sec. 182.002. DELAY <u>OR DEFERRAL</u> OF BILL PAYMENT [DATE] FOR

1 utility shall delay without penalty the payment date of a bill for 2 providing utility service to that individual until the 25th day 3 after the date the bill is issued.

4 <u>(a-1) On written request by an elderly individual or an</u> 5 <u>individual with a disability, a utility shall allow payment of the</u> 6 <u>individual's utility bill to be deferred for not more than three</u> 7 <u>months. The payment plan may not include a penalty for late</u> 8 <u>payments. The payment plan must allow the individual to pay the</u> 9 <u>delinquent amount in equal installments over at least three billing</u> 10 <u>cycles.</u>

11 (b) This subchapter applies only to an elderly individual <u>or</u> 12 an individual with a disability who:

13

(1) is a residential customer; and

14 (2) occupies the entire premises for which a delay <u>or</u>
15 <u>payment deferral</u> is requested.

16 Sec. 182.003. REQUEST FOR DELAY. An elderly individual <u>or</u> 17 <u>an individual with a disability</u> may request that the utility 18 implement the delay under Section <u>182.002(a)</u> [182.002] for:

(1) the most recent utility bill; or

20 (2) the most recent utility bill and each subsequent21 utility bill.

Sec. 182.004. PROOF OF AGE <u>OR DISABILITY</u>. A utility may require an individual requesting a delay <u>or deferral</u> under this subchapter to present reasonable proof that the individual is 60 years of age or older <u>or is an individual with a disability</u>.

26 Sec. 182.005. CERTAIN UTILITIES NOT AFFECTED. This 27 subchapter does not apply to a utility that:

1	(1) does not assess a late payment charge on a
2	residential customer;
3	(2) does not suspend service before the 26th day after
4	the date of the bill for which collection action is taken; [and]
5	(3) offers a deferred payment plan that is at least as
6	generous as the plan required by Section 182.002(a-1); and
7	(4) is regulated under Title 2.
8	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
