S.B. No. 657

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the selection of the local administrative district  
3 judge for Blanco, Burnet, Llano, and San Saba Counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 74.097, Government Code, is amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 74.097. LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT JUDGE FOR  
8 BLANCO, BURNET, LLANO, AND SAN SABA COUNTIES. Notwithstanding  
9 Section 74.091(b), the local administrative district judge for  
10 Blanco, Burnet, Llano, and San Saba Counties is selected on the  
11 basis of rotation [~~seniority~~] from the district judges of the 33rd  
12 Judicial District and the 424th Judicial District.

13 SECTION 2. The judges of the district courts in Blanco,  
14 Burnet, Llano, and San Saba Counties shall select a local  
15 administrative district judge for those counties as required by  
16 Section 74.097, Government Code, as amended by this Act, to begin  
17 the initial rotation for service as the local administrative  
18 district judge on the effective date of this Act.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
