7	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8307 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 8307. CALDWELL COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 8307.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.
12	(2) "Director" means a board member.
13	(3) "District" means the Caldwell County Municipal
14	Utility District No. 1.
15	Sec. 8307.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
16	municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,
17	Texas Constitution.
18	Sec. 8307.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION
19	REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to
20	confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent
21	directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.
22	Sec. 8307.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
23	temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8307.003
24	until each municipality in whose corporate limits or

S.B. No. 660 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has 1 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the 2 3 district and to the inclusion of land in the district. Sec. 8307.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. 4 The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit. 5 (a) (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of: 6 7 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and 8 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that 9 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation, 10 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 11 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. 12 13 Sec. 8307.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is initially composed of the territory described by 14 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter. 15 16 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the 17 18 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process does not affect the district's: 19 20 organization, existence, or validity; 21 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and 22 interest on a bond; 23 24 (3) right to impose a tax; or (4) legality or operation. 25 [Sections 8307.007-8307.050 reserved for expansion] 26

1	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
2	Sec. 8307.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
3	governed by a board of five elected directors.
4	(b) Except as provided by Section 8307.052, directors serve
5	staggered four-year terms.
6	Sec. 8307.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary
7	board consists of:
8	(1) Joseph John Mazzola III;
9	(2) Hunter Wallace Dehn;
10	(3) Seth Thatcher;
11	(4) Scott Guesner; and
12	(5) Mark Solomon.
13	(b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:
14	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
15	Section 8307.003; or
16	(2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of
17	the Act creating this chapter.
18	(c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
19	Section 8307.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have
20	expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
21	reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
22	expire on the earlier of:
23	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
24	Section 8307.003; or
25	(2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
26	appointment or reappointment.
27	(d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a

1 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district 2 may submit a petition to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality requesting that the commission appoint as successor 3 4 temporary directors the five persons named in the petition. The 5 commission shall appoint as successor temporary directors the five 6 persons named in the petition. 7 [Sections 8307.053-8307.100 reserved for expansion] 8 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES 9 Sec. 8307.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for 10 11 which the district is created. Sec. 8307.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 12 13 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, 14 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, 15 Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 16 Sec. 8307.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section 17 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design, 18 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate, 19 20 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 21 22 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. 23 Sec. 8307.104. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A road project must meet all applicable construction standards, 24 zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each 25 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial 26 27 jurisdiction the road project is located.

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1	(b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
2	or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
3	project must meet all applicable construction standards,
4	subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
5	the road project is located.
6	(c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
7	Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
8	specifications of the road project.
9	Sec. 8307.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE
10	OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable
11	requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under
12	Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the
13	creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the
14	district.
15	Sec. 8307.106. LIMITATION ON CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT
16	IN DISTRICT. A developer may not begin construction or development
17	of a project in the district unless the developer has entered into a
18	contract with an appropriate entity for the provision of water and
19	sewer services for the project.
20	Sec. 8307.107. LOCAL ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT. A developer who
21	undertakes a project in the district shall enter into an agreement
22	with the Texas Department of Transportation, the commissioners
23	court of any county in whose jurisdiction the district is located,
24	or another appropriate entity to make improvements in the roads
25	surrounding the district to mitigate any problems with traffic the
26	proposed project is anticipated to cause or create.
27	Sec. 8307.108. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. The

1	district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the
2	district to acquire a site or easement for:
3	(1) a road project authorized by Section 8307.103; or
4	(2) a recreational facility as defined by Section
5	49.462, Water Code.
6	Sec. 8307.109. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
7	be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:
8	(1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and
9	(2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.
10	(b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the
11	division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and
12	duties of the district.
13	(c) Any new district created by the division of the district
14	may not, at the time the new district is created:
15	(1) contain any land outside the area described by
16	Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter; or
17	(2) contain less than 100 acres.
18	(d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition
19	signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of
20	the real property in the district according to the most recent
21	certified appraisal roll for each county in which the district is
22	located, may adopt an order dividing the district.
23	(e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district
24	before or after the date the board holds an election under Section
25	8307.003 to confirm the district's creation.
26	(f) An order dividing the district shall:
27	(1) name each new district;

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1	(2) include the metes and bounds description of the
2	territory of each new district;
3	(3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;
4	and
5	(4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities
6	between or among the new districts.
7	(g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of
8	an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order
9	with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and record the
10	order in the real property records of each county in which the
11	district is located.
12	(h) Any new district created by the division of the district
13	shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by
14	Section 8307.003.
15	(i) Any new district created by the division of the district
16	must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter
17	approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue
18	bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes.
19	(j) Any new district created by the division of the district
20	may divide into two or more districts as provided by this section.
21	[Sections 8307.110-8307.150 reserved for expansion]
22	SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
23	Sec. 8307.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS.
24	(a) The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
25	obligations secured by:
26	(1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or
27	(2) contract payments described by Section 8307.153.

1 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner 2 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval 3 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds 4 payable from ad valorem taxes. 5 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a 6 7 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an election held for that purpose. 8 9 Sec. 8307.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If authorized at an election held under Section 8307.151, the district 10 11 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in 12 the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code. 13 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not 14 exceed the rate approved at the election. Sec. 8307.153. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with 15 16 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from 17 18 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters 19 20 voting at an election held for that purpose. (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a 21 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by 22 23 the board without further voter approval. 24 [Sections 8307.154-8307.200 reserved for expansion] 25 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS Sec. 8307.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS 26 AND OTHER 27 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations

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payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees, 1 2 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district 3 4 purpose. 5 Sec. 8307.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the 6 7 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all 8 9 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code. 10

11 <u>Sec. 8307.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of</u> 12 <u>issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations</u> 13 <u>issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad</u> 14 <u>valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the</u> 15 <u>real property in the district.</u>
