A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to participation in an animal identification system.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 161.056, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsections (a-1), (j), (k), (l), and (m) and amending
- 6 Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) A person may apply for the program by submitting an
- 8 annual fee determined by the commission and a signed application
- 9 prescribed by the commission. An application form prescribed by
- 10 the commission must include a conspicuous notice that the program
- 11 is voluntary unless the United States Department of Agriculture
- 12 <u>imposes a mandatory national animal identification system.</u>
- 13 (c) The commission may <u>permit</u> [<u>require</u>] the use of official
- 14 identification numbers assigned as part of the animal
- 15 identification program for animal disease control, animal
- 16 emergency management, and other commission programs.
- 17 (d) The commission may [establish a date by which all
- 18 premises must be registered and may] assess a registration fee on
- 19 all entities that register for a premises identification number.
- 20 <u>(j) The commission may not make the use of an animal</u>
- 21 identification program under this section mandatory unless a final
- 22 federal rule adopted in accordance with 5 U.S.C. Section 553 makes
- 23 the use of a national animal identification system by persons in
- 24 this state mandatory. If the use of a national animal

- 1 identification system becomes mandatory as provided by this
- 2 subsection, the commission may adopt rules and implement a timeline
- 3 to make the program under this section mandatory, but the rules may
- 4 not be more stringent than the federal rule mandating the use of a
- 5 national animal identification system.
- 6 (k) The commission may not require the use of national
- 7 <u>animal identification system-compliant premises registration or</u>
- 8 animal identification numbers or devices as part of a government
- 9 program except as provided by Subsection (j).
- 10 (1) Unless the commission has developed rules and a timeline
- 11 for implementing a mandatory program under Subsection (j), a person
- 12 who participates in the program may withdraw from the program at any
- 13 time. The commission shall delete from the program all personal
- 14 information relating to a participant when the participant
- 15 withdraws from the program.
- 16 (m) A person may not condition a service, benefit, license,
- 17 payment, or permit on participation in a program under this section
- 18 unless the commission has adopted rules and a timeline for
- 19 implementing a mandatory program under Subsection (j).
- SECTION 2. Sections 161.056(g) and (h), Agriculture Code,
- 21 are repealed.
- 22 SECTION 3. The Texas Animal Health Commission shall, not
- 23 later than November 1, 2009, provide notice of the changes to
- 24 Section 161.056, Agriculture Code, made by this Act to each person
- 25 registered on the effective date of this Act under that section and
- 26 provide the person with the opportunity to withdraw from the
- 27 program.

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- 1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
