- 7 (b) A person who sells a minor an alcoholic beverage does
- 8 not commit an offense if the minor falsely represents himself to be
- 9 21 years old or older by displaying an apparently valid proof of
- 10 identification that contains [<del>Texas driver's license or an</del>
- 11 identification card issued by the Texas Department of Public
- 12 Safety, containing] a physical description and photograph
- 13 consistent with the minor's [his] appearance, purports to establish
- 14 that the minor is 21 years of age or older, and was issued by a
- 15 governmental agency [for the purpose of inducing the person to sell
- 16 him an alcoholic beverage]. The proof of identification may
- 17 <u>include a driver's license or identification card issued by the</u>
- 18 Department of Public Safety, a passport, or a military
- 19 identification card.
- SECTION 2. The defenses added by this Act to Subsection (b),
- 21 Section 160.03, Alcoholic Beverage Code, are available to a person
- 22 regardless of when the offense was committed but only for trials
- 23 commencing on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
