8	authority or water authority listed in Subsection (b) is subject to
9	review and abolishment under this chapter as if it were a state
10	agency.
11	(b) This section applies only to the:
12	(1) Brazos River Authority;
13	(2) Canadian River Municipal Water Authority;
14	(3) Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority;
15	(4) Gulf Coast Water Authority;
16	(5) Lower Colorado River Authority;
17	(6) Lower Neches Valley Authority;
18	(7) Sabine River Authority of Texas;
19	(8) San Antonio River Authority;
20	(9) San Jacinto River Authority; and
21	(10) Trinity River Authority of Texas.
22	(c) A river authority or water authority shall pay the cost
