1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the sale of certain alcoholic beverages to private club
1-9 registration permit holders.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 19.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 19.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a
1-14 wholesaler's permit may:

1-15 (1) purchase and import liquor from distillers,
1-16 brewers, wineries, wine bottlers, rectifiers, and manufacturers
1-17 who are holders of nonresident seller's permits or from their
1-18 agents who hold manufacturer's agents permits;

1-19 (2) purchase liquor from other wholesalers in the
1-20 state;

1-21 (3) sell liquor in the original containers in which it
1-22 is received to retailers and wholesalers in this state authorized
1-23 to sell the liquor; ~~and~~

1-24 (4) sell liquor to qualified persons outside the
1-25 state; and

1-26 (5) sell ale and malt liquor to a holder of a private
1-27 club registration permit.

1-28 SECTION 2. Section 20.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
1-29 amended to read as follows:

1-30 Sec. 20.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a general
1-31 class B wholesaler's permit may:

1-32 (1) purchase and import malt and vinous liquors from
1-33 brewers, wineries, rectifiers, and wine manufacturers and wine
1-34 bottlers who are the holders of nonresident seller's permits or
1-35 their agents who are holders of manufacturer's agent permits;

1-36 (2) purchase malt and vinous liquors from holders of
1-37 brewer's permits or other wholesalers in the state;

1-38 (3) sell the malt and vinous liquors in the original
1-39 containers in which they are received to retailers and wholesalers
1-40 authorized to sell them in this state, including holders of local
1-41 distributor's permits, mixed beverage permits, and daily temporary
1-42 mixed beverage permits; ~~and~~

1-43 (4) sell the malt and vinous liquors to qualified
1-44 persons outside the state; and

1-45 (5) sell ale and malt liquor to a holder of a private
1-46 club registration permit.

1-47 SECTION 3. Section 21.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
1-48 amended to read as follows:

1-49 Sec. 21.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a local
1-50 class B wholesaler's permit may:

1-51 (1) purchase and import malt and vinous liquors from
1-52 brewers, wineries, rectifiers, and wine manufacturers and bottlers
1-53 who are holders of nonresident seller's permits and from their
1-54 agents who are holders of manufacturer's agent permits;

1-55 (2) purchase malt and vinous liquors from holders of
1-56 brewer's permits and from other wholesalers in the state; ~~and~~

1-57 (3) sell the malt and vinous liquors, in the original
1-58 containers in which he receives them, to general and local class B
1-59 wholesaler's permittees and, in his county of residence, to local
1-60 distributor's permittees and retailers, including mixed beverage
1-61 permittees and daily temporary mixed beverage permittees; and

1-62 (4) sell ale and malt liquor to a holder of a private
1-63 club registration permit.

1-64 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
