1	AN ACT
2	relating to notice of a hospital lien.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 55.005, Property Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read
6	as follows:
7	(a) To secure the lien, a hospital or emergency medical
8	services provider must:
9	(1) provide notice to the injured individual in
10	accordance with Subsection (d); and
11	(2) file written notice of the lien with the county
12	clerk of the county in which the services were provided[. The
13	notice must be filed] before money is paid to an entitled person
14	because of the injury.
15	(b) The notice <u>filed under Subsection (a)(2)</u> must contain:
16	(1) the injured individual's name and address;
17	(2) the date of the accident;
18	(3) the name and location of the hospital or emergency
19	medical services provider claiming the lien; [and]
20	(4) the name of the person alleged to be liable for
21	damages arising from the injury, if known; and
22	(5) an affidavit by an agent of the hospital or
23	emergency medical services provider that affirms that the notice to

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the injured individual was given in accordance with Subsection (d).

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- 1 (d) Not later than the 10th day before the date a hospital or
- 2 emergency medical services provider files a notice with the county
- 3 clerk under Subsection (a)(2), the hospital or emergency medical
- 4 services provider must send a written notice to the injured
- 5 individual by certified mail, return receipt requested, that:
- 6 (1) specifies the amount of the unpaid charges that
- 7 are the basis for a lien under this chapter and to whom the charges
- 8 are owed; and
- 9 (2) states that the hospital or emergency medical
- 10 services provider will file a notice of a hospital lien with the
- 11 county clerk of the county in which the services were provided, in
- 12 <u>accordance with Chapter 55, Property Code, if the injured</u>
- 13 individual does not pay the charges before the 10th day after the
- 14 <u>date the notice is sent.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to a lien for services provided to an injured individual on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act. A lien for services provided before
- 18 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 19 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 20 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
