- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.032, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to
- 7 read as follows:

- 8 (a) A company or organization may not distribute to, sell
- 9 to, or grade for the same school district the same form of an
- 10 assessment instrument for more than eight [three] school years. A
- 11 school district may not use the same form of an assessment
- 12 instrument for more than eight [three] years. This subsection does
- 13 not apply if another form of a particular assessment instrument
- 14 does not exist.
- 15 (c) State and national norms of averages shall be computed
- 16 using data that:
- 17 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ are not more than $\underline{\text{eight}}$ [six] years old at the time
- 18 the assessment instrument is administered, unless only data older
- 19 than eight years old are available; and
- 20 <u>(2)</u> [that] are representative of the group of students
- 21 to whom the assessment instrument is administered.
- 22 <u>(c-1)</u> The standardization norms computed under Subsection
- 23 (c) shall be based on a national probability sample that meets
- 24 accepted standards for educational and psychological testing and,

- 1 using proven psychometric procedures approved by the State Board of
- 2 Education, shall be updated at least every eight [six] years,
- 3 unless sufficient data to update the sample are not available
- 4 [using proven psychometric procedures approved by the State Board
- 5 of Education].
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
