A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to a study concerning the minimum participation
- 3 requirement for small employer health benefit plans.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "department" means the
- 6 Texas Department of Insurance.
- 7 SECTION 2. STUDY. (a) The department shall conduct a study
- 8 concerning the minimum participation requirement for small
- 9 employer health benefit plans under Section 1501.154, Insurance
- 10 Code.
- 11 (b) The study must include:
- 12 (1) an evaluation of the effectiveness of a minimum
- 13 collective employee participation level of 60 percent; and
- 14 (2) a comparison of the effectiveness of the current
- 15 minimum collective employee participation level of 75 percent to a
- 16 minimum collective employee participation level of 60 percent.
- 17 SECTION 3. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. The department shall
- 18 include a report of the results of the study conducted under this
- 19 Act in the biennial report to the 82nd Legislature made under
- 20 Section 32.022, Insurance Code. The report must describe the
- 21 results of the study conducted under this Act and must contain:
- 22 (1) a recommendation concerning whether the minimum
- 23 collective employee participation level should be reduced from 75
- 24 percent to 60 percent; and

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- 1 (2) the reasons for the recommendation described by
- 2 Subdivision (1).
- 3 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 4 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 5 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 6 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 7 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
