- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 61.011, Natural
- 5 Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (d) The commissioner shall promulgate rules, consistent
- 7 with the policies established in this section, on the following
- 8 matters only:
- 9 (1) acquisition by local governments or other
- 10 appropriate entities or public dedication of access ways sufficient
- 11 to provide adequate public ingress and egress to and from the beach
- 12 within the area described in Subdivision (6);
- 13 (2) protection of the public easement from erosion or
- 14 reduction caused by development or other activities on adjacent
- 15 land and beach cleanup and maintenance;
- 16 (3) local government prohibitions of vehicular
- 17 traffic on public beaches, provision of off-beach parking, use of
- 18 motorized golf cart vehicles on the beach by disabled persons, and
- 19 other minimum measures needed to mitigate for any adverse effect on
- 20 public access and dune areas;
- 21 (4) imposition of beach access, user, or parking fees
- 22 and reasonable exercises of the police power by local governments
- 23 with respect to public beaches;
- 24 (5) contents and certification of beach access and use

- 1 plans and standards for local government review of construction on
- 2 land adjacent to and landward of public beaches, including
- 3 procedures for expedited review of beach access and use plans under
- 4 Section 61.015;
- 5 (6) construction on land adjacent to and landward of
- 6 public beaches and lying in the area either up to the first public
- 7 road generally parallel to the beach or to any closer public road
- 8 not parallel to the beach, or to within 1,000 feet of mean high
- 9 tide, whichever is greater, that affects or may affect public
- 10 access to and use of public beaches;
- 11 (7) the temporary suspension under Section 61.0185 of
- 12 enforcement of the prohibition against encroachments on and
- 13 interferences with the public beach easement and the ability of a
- 14 property owner to make repairs to a house while a suspension is in
- 15 effect;
- 16 (8) the determination of the line of vegetation or
- 17 natural line of vegetation;
- 18 (9) the factors to be considered in determining
- 19 whether a structure, improvement, obstruction, barrier, or hazard
- 20 on the public beach:
- 21 (A) constitutes an imminent hazard to safety,
- 22 health, or public welfare; or
- 23 (B) substantially interferes with the free and
- 24 unrestricted right of the public to enter or leave the public beach
- 25 or traverse any part of the public beach; and
- 26 (10) the procedures for determining whether a
- 27 structure is not insurable property for purposes of Section

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- 1 2210.004, Insurance Code, because of the factors listed in
- 2 Subsection (h) of that section.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
