1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the election, and validation of acts, of members of the
1-9 board of directors of Anderson County Underground Water
1-10 Conservation District.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 9, Chapter 992, Acts of the 70th
1-13 Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 9. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. ~~An [Beginning in the second~~
1-15 ~~year following the creation election, an]~~ election shall be held on
1-16 the uniform election date ~~[third Saturday]~~ in May every two years to
1-17 elect the appropriate number of directors to the board.

1-18 SECTION 2. (a) All governmental and proprietary actions of
1-19 the Anderson County Underground Water Conservation District taken
1-20 before the effective date of this Act are validated, ratified, and
1-21 confirmed in all respects as if the actions had been taken as
1-22 authorized by law.

1-23 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
1-24 effective date of this Act:

1-25 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
1-26 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
1-27 judgment; or

1-28 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.

1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
