6 Sec. 33.901. BREAKFAST PROGRAMS. (a) If at least 10 7 percent of the students enrolled in one or more schools in a school

8 district or enrolled in an open-enrollment charter school are

eligible for free or reduced-price breakfasts under the national

10 school breakfast program provided for by the Child Nutrition Act of

11 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section 1773), the governing body of the district or

12 the open-enrollment charter school shall participate in the program

13 and make the benefits of the program available to all eligible

14 students in the schools or school.

(b) A school district campus or an open-enrollment charter

16 school participating in the national school breakfast program

17 provided by the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section 1773)

18 <u>in which 60 percent or more of the students qualify for a free or</u>

19 reduced-price breakfast shall provide a free breakfast to an

20 elementary school student during school hours. The Department of

21 Agriculture shall reimburse the school district or open-enrollment

22 charter school for any lost revenue resulting from a free breakfast

23 provided under this subsection.
