A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the purchase of continued health insurance coverage by
- 3 an eligible survivor of certain public servants killed in the line
- 4 of duty.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 615.077, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 615.077. PAYMENTS; RATE. An eligible survivor who is
- 9 entitled to continued coverage under this subchapter [is entitled
- 10 to]:

11 (1) is entitled to:

- 12 (A) make payments for the coverage or have
- 13 payments made on the survivor's behalf at the same time and to the
- 14 same entity that payments for coverage are made by current
- 15 employees of the employing entity; and
- (B) obtain [(2) purchase] the coverage at the
- 17 [group] rate paid by current employees of the employing entity for
- 18 that coverage; and
- 19 (2) may not be required to pay a premium amount for the
- 20 coverage that is greater than the premium amount that a current
- 21 employee of the employing entity without a spouse is required to pay
- 22 to cover the employee alone or to cover the employee and the
- 23 employee's dependent children, as applicable to the eligible
- 24 survivor [that exists at the time of payment].

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 615, Government Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 615.080 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 615.080. LIMITED OPPORTUNITY FOR CERTAIN ELIGIBLE
- 4 SURVIVORS TO REAPPLY FOR COVERAGE. (a) This section applies only
- 5 to an eligible survivor of a deceased individual listed under
- 6 Section 615.071 who died on or after September 1, 1993.
- 7 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter
- 8 or other law, an eligible survivor to whom this section applies who
- 9 did not purchase continued health insurance benefits under this
- 10 subchapter or under the law codified by this subchapter within the
- 11 time allowed after the listed individual's death, or who
- 12 <u>discontinued coverage under this subchapter or under the law</u>
- 13 codified by this subchapter after the listed individual's death,
- 14 may reapply for coverage under the employing entity's health
- insurance benefits plan not later than March 1, 2010.
- (c) An eligible survivor who reapplies for coverage under
- 17 Subsection (b) is entitled to purchase the coverage according to
- 18 the same rate schedule and coverage options as would apply had the
- 19 eligible survivor continued coverage under this subchapter after
- 20 the listed individual's death.
- 21 (d) This section expires September 1, 2010.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
